turned upside down. She started to notice the first signs of abuse. For four years she was beaten and abused physically, mentally and emotionally. Elizabeth Savage was told "She wasn't worth anything, she was ugly, a good for nothing piece of crap". She was also told "God wasted His time on her". She started believing that she didn't have a purpose, her self-esteem was shattered to a point where she did not know who she was; all the goals and dreams she had disappeared. She was afraid in her own home, a place that was supposed to be her place of safety. She suffered through the mental & verbal abuse every day.

Elizabeth Savage founded S.T.A.N.D organization in 2010; an organization focused on inspiring and bringing hope to broken women, men and teens that have experienced challenges in their life. As part of her commitment to inspiring and bringing hope to those that have been victims of sexual and domestic violence, Elizabeth is sharing her story. Elizabeth is in the process of writing her book titled, "Who I Am and Who I'm Not".
